

# Inspiration Coupons

Sometime you may lack the photography inspiration to go out and do a shoot either because you couldn't figure out what to "invent" as the subject matter or just because you're not into black & white, macro or even just because...

Has this ever happened to you? Well stop worrying about it and pay attention to this



What you need to do after printing these on a sheet of paper is to cut out all the coupons and separate them into 3 piles - one for the "Themes & Subjects", the other for "Lens/Focal Length" and the last pile for the "Time of Day/Lighting" coupons. Next mix each pile in a separate bag or box.

Start by grabbing one coupon from the "Themes & Subjects" pile and that will be your Theme or Subject for the shoot, then you just have to follow the same procedure for each of the other piles.

So for example you could be drawing Urban Landscape + Prime Lens + Daylight, got it?

If you do not have one particular lens (e.g. macro or a wide lens) then you remove that coupon from the pile.
